

QUINCY FAMILY VISITOR POLICY

Day Pass

Nonmembers can use the YMCA by filling out a day pass application and paying the day pass fee.

Cost: Adult - \$9 Active Older Adult - \$7 Teen - \$7 Youth - \$5 Family - \$20

This pass is also used for members of area YMCA's that come to use the facility.

Cost: Hannibal - \$3 Keokuk - \$3 Mt. Sterling Adult - \$3 Mt. Sterling Family - \$6

Active military that do not qualify for the free military membership can also use a day pass.

Cost: Military - \$5

Away Program

When members from other YMCA's visit Quincy, they can use the Quincy Family YMCA for 2 weeks. After the two weeks is up, the visitor must then purchase day passes.

The visitor must sign the Visitor's Sign In sheet. The front desk associate will then call the member's home YMCA to verify membership before allowing the individual to enter the YMCA.

Sign-In Sheet

The sign-in sheet should be used by out of town YMCA members as well as the various groups allowed to use the YMCA through agreements set up by the business office. These groups include but are not limited to Great River Recovery Resources, Big Brothers Big Sisters, Madonna House, the Quincy Gems and Chaddock. Individual from these organizations or any of the other must sign in each time they visit the YMCA.

The front desk associate is responsible for ensuring the guest legibly fills out the date, time, their name and the organization they are with.
